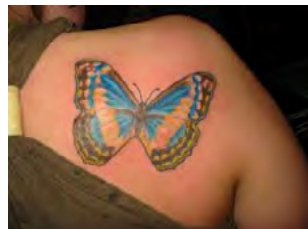

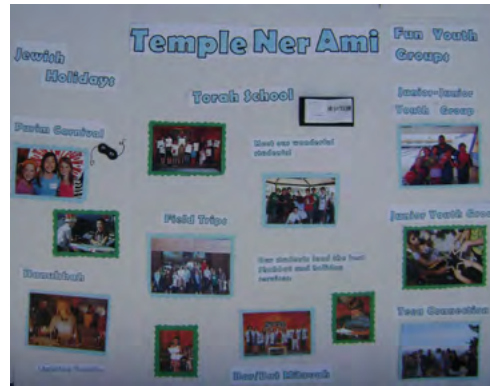

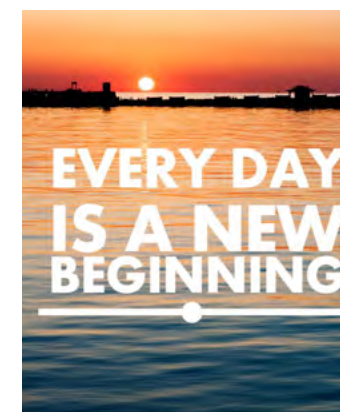


EVERY DAY IS A NEW BEGINNING

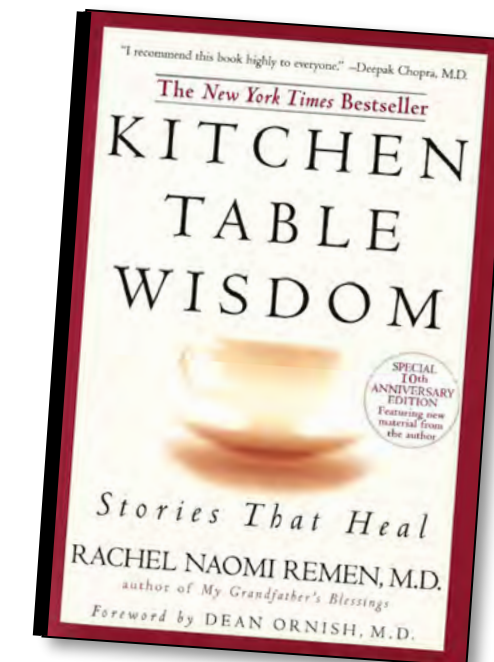
August Book: KITCHEN TABLE WISDOM

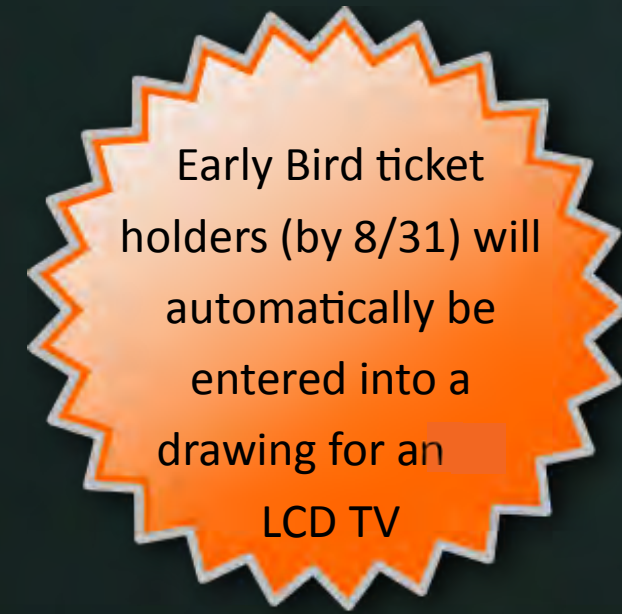


